The "Bad" Bills

HB24-1353: Firearms Dealer **Requirements & Permits**

The bill mandates that firearms dealers in Colorado obtain a state firearm dealer permit, in addition to holding a federal firearms license, to legally deal in firearms

SB24-066: Firearms Merchant **Category** Code

Processors must assign a code to each firearms merchant they service. Violations are subject to a \$10,000 fine per infraction, enforced by the attorney general's office.
